**Communication, language and literacy**

Our book of the week would be 'Farm Hullabaloo. If you don't have the book at home, then you can use YouTube to access the story. Have you ever visited a farm? What animals did you see? Play a game of who am I? e.g, I am pink and have a curly tail, who am I?

**Physical Development**

Practise your physical skills with some throwing and catching. You could use a ball or a cuddly toy. Can you throw a ball into a bucket?

**Fine Motor skills**

Practice your fine motor skills by doing some threading  
What items in your house can you find to thread onto string or pipe cleaners? Pasta? Buttons? Large beads?

**Knowledge and understanding of the world**

If you go on a walk or out on your daily exercise, Can you spot any horses or sheep in a field? Can you count how many there is of each animal? Talk about what sounds you hear or any smells.

**Maths**

If you have any farm animal toys at home, Can you sort them into groups? You could even sort them into size order or colours.



**Expressive arts and design**

Create a sheep picture using cotton wool or textured paper.

What else could you use for legs? What textures can you find at home to create your sheep?



**Music**

What farm animal songs can you sing? Our favourites are Old McDonald had a farm, Bingo the dog and 5 little ducks.
