Expressive arts and design

Can you make Spinderella?
 These pictures show you how to make a pompom Spinderella, can you find a different way?
 Explain why you have chosen the colours and materials that you have.

YOU WILL NEED

Black or any colour wool / Super glue / 2 cardboard squares / Some googly eyes / Black pipe cleaners / Scissors / A pencil / *Big or small this will be the size of your pom pom.

Draw two circles on your cardboard. They need to be exactly the same so it's best to use something to draw around. Cut out your two doughnut shapes!

Cut a length from your wool! It doesn't need to be exact! Then, holding your two doughnuts together, start the end of your wool between them and begin to wind the wool through and around the doughnuts.

Keep going until you've covered all the cardboard. If you need more wool, just tie the old length and new length together and carry on.

Carefully using scissors cut down the middle of the two pieces of cardboard, through the wool. Be careful, as scissors can be sharp!

Once you've cut the wool, carefully remove the cardboard (fig. 6) Tie a length of your wool around the middle to secure (fig. 6) And fluff out your pom pom (fig. 6)

Take four pipe cleaners and wind around each other at four midpoints. Bend them so your spider has some legs.

Attach legs to your pom pom body using a length of wool. Using your glue, stick your googly eyes to the pom pom and maybe even a little tongue! It's up to you!

Congratulations you're all done! Enjoy this prop when reading Spinderella!
