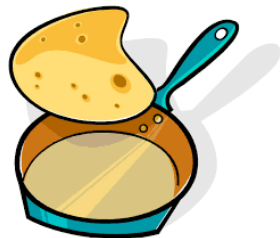


In our classes this week.....

This week, Class 3 have continued to explore materials in science. We created some casein plastic and carbon dioxide, observing as the reactants caused a chemical change which resulted in a new product.

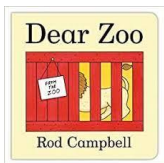


We have explored mechanisms within D.T. and are learning to tell the time in our French lessons.
