We enjoyed designing our fabric face purses that we will make next week in Design & Technology.

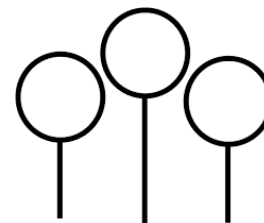
We have been learning about the importance of a healthy diet, good hygiene and exercise. Ask children at home to tell you what they have remembered.
