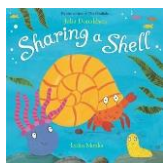


In our classes this week.....

This week in Nursery we have been reading the story 'Sharing a Shell'. We have enjoyed decorating our own shells with different colours and patterns.



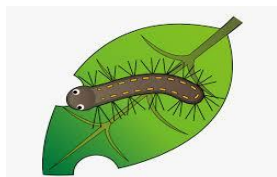
We have loved playing in our small world beach and talking about different creatures that live in the sea.
