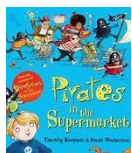


In our classes this week.....

We had a great time competing on sports day, well done everyone!

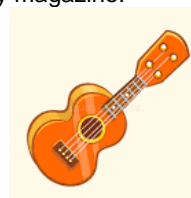


Class 2
