

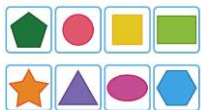
In our classes this week.....

EYFS

This week in nursery we have focused on shape names and shapes within the environment, we have also had lots of fun using building blocks to build towers.

Reception class have been introduced to their first two tricky words and have made lots of progress in phonics. For maths we have looked at ordering objects based on size, length and capacity.

In art the children have made leaf print pictures which they collected themselves.



Key Stage 1

In history, KS1 have enjoyed acting out the events of the Gunpowder Plot and sequencing these events chronologically.

We have practised playing the notes C, D and E on the glockenspiels in music and the children have enjoyed composing pieces of music with these notes. Some children impressed us by performing their compositions to the class.

In maths, the Year 1 children have completed their place value unit and will be moving onto addition and subtraction within 10 and Year 2 are continuing to learn about addition and subtraction.

Key Stage 2 – Lower

This week we looked at different places of worship including inside a mosque. We completed some abstract pieces of art using oil pastels and we also had a look at some artefacts that were used in the Stone Age. We finished off the week with a netball tournament.



Key stage 2 – Upper

This week we have been finding out how children were educated during the Georgian era. In our art sessions the children used water colour paints to explore the work of the abstract artist Helen Frankenthaler. In science we have been finding out about the gestation periods of different animals.
